These cards were the first post cards issued by the Republic after the 1952 revolution. That is why there is a soldier in the indicium. The cards were intended to re-attract tourists after the revolution and after abolishing monarchy.

The series consists of four sets of 25 cards, each set with the same views. All cards have the same indicium. The cards differ in the color of the ornamental border and all of the text which have the same color as the view. These four colors are:



All cards are strictly alphabetically numbered according to their caption's first character.
